Leaving Cert Mock Examinations: 23rd January – 3rd February

The timetable for the Mock Examinations has been attached to this letter. The exam fee for this year has been set at €30 (€15 for LCA) which can be paid through Way2pay. This includes the provision of the exam papers, CD's, DVD's and answer booklets required for all mock exams for your son/daughter. A text message will be sent with a link to Way2pay. This fee does not cover the cost of exam corrections.

The main exams will take place in the school hall and specialist rooms to support Aural or Visual exams. Support for students with additional needs will be discussed with the students individually.

The Code of Conduct for exams is available on the back of the timetable. Please read this with your son or daughter and ensure that they are familiar with them. Disruptive behaviour or an attempt to cheat in a state exam may result in a candidate being prevented from completing their exams for five years.

All students are expected to be in their exam centre at the start of the earliest exam in that session. There are a small number of occasions when your son or daughter may not be scheduled for an exam. They are expected to study in the exam hall under the direct supervision of staff at this time. They may leave the school at this time, only if you are available to sign them out in line with our normal procedures. Please DO NOT share your vsware password with your child.
